

MINUTES

Southeast Colorado Art Guild

Meeting called to order at 9:40 by President, Jennie Dooley. Eleven members were present.

1. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
2. Treasurer's report: Veronica Jacoby reported that the balance was \$298.06 and after expenses and deposit from Shore display moneys the balance is \$100.78
3. Jeremy Cooper asked the Shore display stay up through the Snow Goose Festival in Feb.
4. The nominations were read. Jeff Alexander made a motion to accept the nomination report and it was seconded by Veronica Jacoby. The 2010 officers are:

5. Carol Demas will audit the Treasurer's books before turning them over to Patsy Oxley. Jeremy Cooper will ask Mary Lynne Pruett to assist Carol.
6. Jeremy asked that the by-laws be added as follows:
 - Article V: changed to eliminate the last sentence in it.
 - Article VI: to state: The Art Show will be held in October, the date to be decided by the organization.
7. Bev Middleton would like the Shore window display to have only 1 person being featured occasionally. Everyone agreed.
8. We need e-mail addresses of all the members.
9. Carol said the Chamber of Commerce will advertise our Autumn Art Show, but we need a date for it. We will know the date by our April meeting. The by-laws state that we have the show the second week of October through the third week. This year, we plan to have entries on Oct. 16, and check-out on the 24th. Veronica will notify the library.
10. The next SECAG meeting will be April 24th at the Perk at 9:30 a.m.
11. Jennie will do a workshop after the end of March. If it is to be oils, it will be two Saturday mornings.
12. The Snow Goose Festival is Feb,25-28. Registration is Thursday from 4:00-8:00 at the Shore building and Friday fro 4:00-8:00 at the Eagles lodge. The art display will be at the Shore building during the registration times. If anyone wants a booth at the High School, the cost is \$20.00 each.

13. A suggestion was made to put an ad in the goose festival entrants goodie bags advertising our Autumn Art Show, the Shore art display, etc. 100 copies was suggested. Jeff will do a sheet with art show dates, the website, etc. to go in the bags.
14. Patsy suggested a tour of artists' studios for a fee for a money-making project. Karen Voepel said we were welcome to come to her studio, and we could have booths, etc. Maybe we could hold a meeting at her studio in the future.
15. Karen is having a photography show sometime and will donate a percent of her proceeds to SECAG.
16. Diana Dooley suggested having "Art at the Fair," maybe having someone demonstrating art at times in a booth.
